

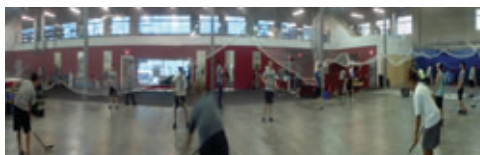


Overview...

Rarely do young elite female hockey players from around the world have the opportunity to combine tremendous skating and skill development with great exposure to NCAA/CIS coaches all in one compact 4 day experience.

Development...

Have your skating videotaped and analyzed; your skating technique, quickness, speed and agility improved while working with one of the world's top skating coaches, David Roy. Help ingrain changes in your neuromuscular skating patterns through the use of on-ice video projection. Combine this, with the opportunity to work daily on your shooting and stickhandling while being instructed by coaches from the Pursuit of Excellence Hockey Academy, in our 25,000 sq ft POE Training Facility. The girls will also have the opportunity to use specific computerized training equipment like VERT, the Dynavision Board, and Smart Speed System during the off-ice sessions.



Goaltenders...

There will be specific goaltending sessions where they will have their movements videotaped and reviewed with our goalie coach. There will be off-ice sessions specific to goaltending. With only 6 teams the number of goalie spots available is extremely limited so apply right away.



Exposure...

In addition, these girls will play 4 full-length, 2 hour games in front of coaches such as Peter Elander, former Head Coach of

the female Swedish Olympic Team, now a coach with the female Division One, University of Dakota Fighting Sioux.

Fun...

Aside from meeting and training with elite female hockey players from other countries such as Sweden and Germany, we have another surprise! On Saturday, the girls will experience the beauty and excitement of a 3 hour boat cruise exploring Lake Okanagan in Kelowna... **and this is all included in the price of attending.** The girls will travel in style on "The Executive Boardroom" Kelowna's Premiere Boat Cruise Charter.

Easter Weekend...

Because POE Hockey Academy strongly believes in the development of the 360 degree player, we will have an optional non-denominational worship service on Good Friday right at the POE Training Centre led by one of our local youth pastors.

Showcase Details...

Date: Thursday, April 5th thru Sunday, April 8th, 2012 (Easter Weekend). These are **4 FULL DAYS**. Players will have to arrive on Wednesday April 4th by 5pm to check-in and attend the Wednesday night meeting at the POE Training Centre at 7pm. The games will go right until 10pm on Sunday evening.

Location: Kelowna, British Columbia, Canada. Players should fly into Kelowna International Airport.

Eligible Players: The Development Showcase is open to female players who are 95s, 96s, and 97s and who have aspirations of playing at the University or College level. A limited number of 94s will be accepted as well. Because of the amount of development ice time and full length games in 4 days, we are only able to accept enough players for 6 teams. We will also have some elite European players attending.

Facilities: All on-ice sessions will be at Winfield Arena (15 min. from Kelowna International Airport and 25 min. from Kelowna) and all off-ice/skill development sessions will be at the 25,000 sqft POE Training Centre (5 min. from the Kelowna International Airport and 15 min. from downtown)

Daily Schedule: The following is a sample of a player's daily schedule for each of the 4 days. The time of day for different teams will vary but the components of 1 hour on-ice development, 1 hour of off-ice, 1 hour of skills development, 1 hour of POE Class session with speakers and a 2 hour game each day, is the same.

2:00pm - 2 :45pm	Back to Hotel or Billets (pregame meal)
2:45pm - 4:45pm	Rest
4:30pm - 5:30pm	Pre-Game Off-Ice warm up
6:00pm - 8:00pm	Game
10:00pm	Curfew / Lights Out
